

Artur Wasilewski – Vice-President of the Management Board, Economic and Financial Affairs

Mr Artur Wasilewski graduated from the Lublin University of Technology in 1998 with a degree in Management and Marketing. In 2000 he completed postgraduate studies in Corporate Finance and Capital Market. In 2003 he graduated with a Master of Business Administration degree from Warsaw University & University of Illinois. He has participated in multiple training courses in the domains of finance and reporting according to the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS/IAS).

In the years 1998 – 2000, he worked as a financial analyst at a consultancy firm DEMOS Sp. z o.o., gaining experience in the scope of analysis and price estimation of enterprises, consulting implementations of efficiency solutions, preparing privatisation reports for the Polish Ministry of Treasury.

He is a Member of Supervisory Boards of companies, including Łęczyńska Energetyka Sp. z o.o., PHU Górnik Sp. z o.o., PKS Chełm, Górnik Transport Sp. z o.o., and Inwestycja S.A.

Since 2000 he has been part of Lubelski Węgiel BOGDANKA S.A. Within the company, he has climbed the career ladder from Financial Analyst, Manager of Planning and Analysis to Chief Economist. Since 2013 he served as the Controlling Director and in 2018 he took the position of Controlling and Finance Director.

For a number of years now, he has been actively supporting the development of Lubelski Węgiel Bogdanka S.A. He participated in preparing and then implementing the Company's development strategy, and in obtaining funds through the IPO and bond issue programmes. He participated in the implementation of cost optimisation programmes and CAPEX. He was also a participant of IT-related development programmes, including the implementation of the Business Intelligence system. He took part in determining future guidelines within the Company's current development strategy until 2025, within a 2030 framework.
