

INFORMATION CLAUSE

Personal Data Controller

The controller of your personal data is Lubelski Węgiel Bogdanka SA with its registered office in Bogdanka, 21-013 Puchaczów, Tax Reg. No. (NIP): 713-000-57-84, Industry Id. No. (REGON): 430309210 (hereinafter: **the Controller**).

The scope of processing data

The purpose of processing personal data

Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of electronic transmission by Lubelski Węgiel Bogdanka SA of information for stakeholders, in particular new stock information – current and periodic reports, results and information on events for investors and analysts (legal basis: Article 6(1)(a) of GDPR).

After withdrawing consent, we process your personal data based on the legitimate interest of the controller only in security copies, i.e. on the basis of Article 6(1)(f) of GDPR as part of the Controller's legitimate interest in ensuring the continuity of the IT system's operation.

Providing your personal data is voluntary, however, failure to do so will prevent us from achieving the above-mentioned purposes of data processing, i.e. sending a newsletter.

The right to withdraw consent

We process your personal data based on the granted consent, therefore you have the right to withdraw this consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing that was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal. The right referred to above may be exercised via a dedicated link placed in the footer of the email with the newsletter, as well as by contacting us at the above email address.

Data storage period

Personal data received from you will be stored until you object to its processing or withdrawal of consent granted under separate provisions, or until the contact details are revealed to be useless. The Controller may store your personal data for a longer period than indicated only if it results from the obligation imposed on the Controller by the provisions of generally applicable law or if there is another basis for processing your data specified in Article 6(1) of GDPR.

Data transfer

The processing of your personal data may be entrusted by the Controller to service or product providers acting on its behalf, in particular entities providing IT services to the Controller.

Your personal data will not be transferred to a third country within the meaning of GDPR (outside the European Economic Area) and will not be processed in an automated manner.

Your rights

You have the right to request access to your data, its rectification, object to its processing, request its deletion, processing restriction, transfer, as well as the right not to be subject to automated decision making, including profiling.

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, if you feel that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of GDPR.
